The social and economic unsteadiness of the past few years has reiterated the importance of balance in our operations. Moorelands Kids has navigated the waves of change in 2022 carefully, returning to in-person programming for the first time since the start of the pandemic in 2020.

Returning to in-person programming at *Moorelands Camp* reconnected many kids and families to our community – it was evident that campers needed a break away from the stress of the city more than ever. Their need and desire to reconnect, explore nature, make new friends, and develop their leadership skills inspired us! Our goal is to serve many more kids in 2023.

Our after-school programs brought some new challenges this year. In 2022, the communities where our programs were well established continued to face incredible barriers as they tried to recover from the pandemic. Moorelands responded by modifying our outreach and registration approach, offering more support for families new to the programs. In order to better serve youth, a key adjustment was the piloting of our high school program, *VITAL*, as a hybrid model with online and in-person youth programming.

We are so grateful for the steadfast support of our donor community. Your dedication has allowed us to remain resilient in the face of adversity, so that we can continue to rebuild our capacity and **Serve More Kids, Serve Kids More** in 2023. Thank you for believing in our mission and the potential of kids to succeed!

Financial Overview

As Chair of the Finance Committee, it is my pleasure to bring you the results of the 2022 Audited Financial Statements for Moorelands Kids.

Due to Moorelands fiscal stewardship and best practices in financial management, we are pleased to announce that we have once again been awarded a **5-star** recognition with **Charity Intelligence**, which means that Moorelands Kids has been named a **Top 100 Charity in Canada** for the third year in a row!

As an organization, Moorelands Kids has remained steadfast in our commitment to serving at-risk children and youth throughout the challenging economic landscape. Our dedicated staff have ensured that the integrity of our resources, donated dollars and gifts-in-kind were directed to deliver quality after-school and camp experiences for kids from low-income families.

In 2022, Moorelands returned to in-person programs with reduced capacity. Looking forward, we plan to not only return to pre-pandemic capacity, but to continue to grow and reach more kids.

The Board of Directors has overseen the strategic growth of Moorelands Kids in meeting its operating fiscal goals for 2022. Our \$191K operating surplus allowed us to invest \$143K in several needed capital projects such as a new dock system, barge motor and a trailer for deliveries, ensuring that camp was ready for kids to return. As we continue to eye growth, further capital investment is needed to enable Moorelands to be well positioned to serve more kids.

We are dedicated to ensuring that Moorelands Kids remains financially sustainable while maintaining integrity in delivering quality resources for vulnerable kids. Thank you for your financial support. Together we can make a difference for kids who might otherwise be on the fringes of society!

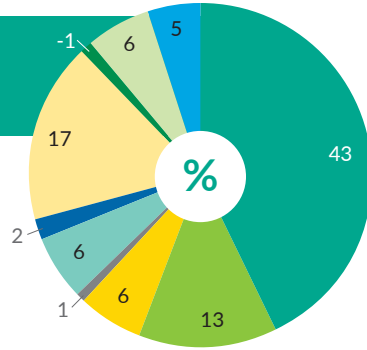

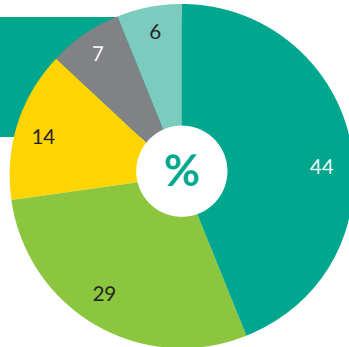
Revenue by Source 2022 (Operating Funds)

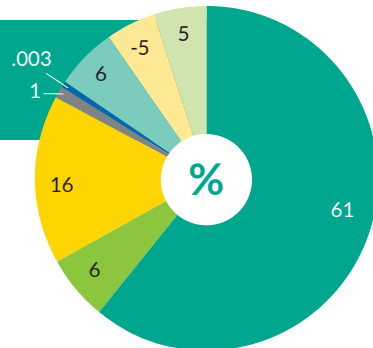
Operating Expenses 2022

A Letter From the Director of Development & Communications

The reach of Moorelands Kids grows only with the generosity of our friends. With the continued commitment of our donors, Moorelands Kids has rebuilt connections in the communities where we provide programming. Returning to in-person programs allowed us to reconnect with at-risk children and youth, rebuilding their resiliency as we begin to rebuild our capacity!

We faced new challenges in 2022 as we observed heightened levels of mental health struggles for families living in poverty. Those living with financial challenges were hardest hit during the pandemic, with low-income parents 12% more likely to postpone their return to work due to difficulties accessing childcare (Statistics Canada, 2021). Moorelands Kids remained determined in the face of these challenges, and provided new mental health training for staff so that we are better equipped to address the needs of children and youth in our programs.

The economic landscape has shifted significantly since the pandemic and has impacted all of us on one level or another. Yet in the face of this, Moorelands Kids was able to achieve its fundraising goals in 2022 because of our community of supporters who continued to invest in our mission.

As we look towards our future growth, we are deeply grateful to YOU for your belief in our mission, in the work we do, and in the transformative impact Moorelands Kids has in the lives of marginalized children and youth. Supporting Moorelands Kids reflects your belief in the potential of marginalized kids to succeed, as we equip them with the tools they need to thrive, and not just survive!

Our intentional programs are built using the **Positive Youth Development** framework to empower marginalized children and youth. Each program allows kids to practise the Moorelands Kids Habits & Qualities as displayed below.



Moorelands Camp



Moorelands Camp is an overnight camp located on scenic Kawagama Lake in Dorset, Ontario. At camp, kids have the opportunity to develop leadership skills, build confidence, make friends, and experience fun outdoor activities in a safe and supportive environment. *Moorelands Camp* activities include:

Mariah's Camp Story

When 15-year-old Mariah arrived at *Moorelands Camp* for the first time in 2019, she was nervous. "I was scared because I had never been to camp before. It was all new to me and it was very far from home," Mariah says. "One of the main challenges was getting used to not being at home with my parents. The first time I went, I didn't want to sleep there because I missed home a lot."

But with the support of her cabin leaders and new friends, she became more comfortable and was excited to return to camp the next summer. Now, Mariah has attended *Moorelands Camp* for three summers, and each time, she comes out of her shell a little bit more.

"My favourite part of camp is definitely getting to meet new people," says Mariah. "Everyone is from different places."

She also speaks about the lessons learned at *Moorelands Camp*:

"We learn leadership skills, like taking responsibility for ourselves. We learn to reflect on our actions and how they affect others."

One of Mariah's best camp memories was her first canoe trip. At first, she did not want to go, but it ended up being her favourite experience and she was glad she did it.

"I feel like *Moorelands Camp* showed me to not always stay in my shell," says Mariah, who is excited to attend camp again this summer. "It's good to try new things, talk to new people and open up more."

Mariah's story demonstrates how our programs build confidence and inspire youth to push themselves to try new things and to keep developing their leadership skills.



Moorelands City Programs

Moorelands After-School Programs

Moorelands Kids offers three **after-school programs** for children and youth in Neighbourhood Improvement Areas (NIAs) across Toronto:

BLAST for Grades 1-5

LED for Grades 6-8

VITAL for Grades 9-12

Success Story: COVID-19 Changes Here to Stay

Back in 2020, our after-school programs pivoted to virtual programming in response to the pandemic. These online programs kept kids connected and focused on development when they needed it the most.

One program in particular, VITAL, thrived in this new environment. The online sessions created an unexpected but vibrant sense of community for our oldest group of youth. It was due to this success that we decided to carry a modified hybrid approach forward into 2022.

In the fall of 2022, we started with two groups, 24 participants in total, meeting weekly on a Zoom call led by our staff. A typical hour-long session begins with community time to share how their weeks are going. From there, the group is led through a leadership activity and discussion. Recently, this was the topic of discussion:

If we, as a group, found ourselves stranded on an island, what role would we all take? How does this lean into our individual and team strengths?



In addition, they plan periodic in-person excursions within the GTA. In December, the teams visited **Dis/Mantle**, an art exhibit at Spadina House, to learn about the history of Black abolitionists in Canada. In January, the team tried their hands at mini putt, an activity new to the whole group. These experiences have fostered important friendships, introduced them to new experiences within their city, and allowed them to practise the Moorelands Kids Habits & Qualities.

As we approach the end of this school year, the VITAL youth have started to practise leadership by planning and running sessions for each other. They also reflect on how they can incorporate the Habits & Qualities in their everyday lives moving forward into adulthood.

Family Programs

In order to serve kids more, Moorelands Kids also offers support to families through *Baby Bundles* and our *Christmas Holiday Program*.



Baby Bundles

Baby Bundles provides new mothers living below the poverty line with a package of essential goods for their newborn during a vulnerable time: receiving blankets, sleepers, sweaters and more.

Ayana's Story

In 2022, Moorelands Kids distributed 217 *Baby Bundles*. One of those bundles went to Ayana, who left her husband and three children in Ethiopia to seek protection and a better life for her family in Canada. As soon as she arrived in Toronto, Ayana discovered she was pregnant with her fourth child.

Alone with no family or friends in Canada, she lived in a downtown shelter and relied on social assistance. She was excited to have another child, but she worried about extra expenses. The money she received from Ontario Works only covered food and shelter; she did not have extra money.

Ayana was happy to receive a Moorelands Kids *Baby Bundle* through our partner agency, **St. Stephen's Community House**. She found all the contents to be nice and useful, and was able to learn more about baby products in Canada. Now Ayana knows that she can save some money on these items and use it toward other necessities while she waits to be reunited with her family in Toronto.



Christmas Holiday Program

Our ***Christmas Holiday Program*** links donors to families through sponsorship or "adoption," providing Christmas gifts, grocery gift cards and holiday joy to families in need. For many families, these sponsorships are their only chance to put gifts under the tree.
